Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Notice is given that THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 19, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act'), the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

The effect of the made Order will be to introduce waiting restrictions (DYL means double yellow lines "no waiting at any time" restrictions) on the following length of roads:-

Roads in the Borough of Ashford

Mead Road: (1) The introduction of DYL at the junction with Bath Road (2) The introduction of double yellow lines at the junction with Canterbury Road (3) the introduction of double yellow lines on the southwestern side of the road between Bath Road and Canterbury Road.

Canterbury Road: (1) The introduction of DYL at the junction with Mead Road (2) the introduction of DYL at the junction with Crowbridge Link

Boys Hall Road: The introduction of DYL on both sides of the road between Crowbridge Link and Shangri La.

Paper Lane: The removal of 30m of DYL on the southeastern side of the carriageway to allow extra parking capacity

The Order was made on 28/11/2024 and its provisions will come into effect on 05/12/2024.

A full statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, a plan indicating the location and the effect and a copy of any other Orders which will be amended by the made Order may be viewed online from 29/11/2024 at www.ashford.gov.uk/parking

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement to the Orders.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Kent County Council, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers and under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 19, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 49, 51, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 5th day of December 2024 and may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Ashford) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2023 (Amendment No.16) Order 2024" ('this Order')
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Ashford) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2023" ('the Order of 2023') shall have effect as though:
